# Updated Information: 5/24/13 to the Auriesville Pilgrimage

Relations with the Martyrs Shrine have always been somewhat strained. However, this year has seen worse developments with refusal of the shrine to allow us the usual 3 day use of the camping field and pavilion and have changed the bylaws to reflect this.

However, parking on the shrine grounds is permitted, along with 'visitor use' of the grounds, but only during the daylight hours.

These changes will not deter us from giving honor & glory to God through His martyrs by this pilgrimage.

Refer to the map on the inside of the pamphlet for a substitute location for both camping and Mass. Please respect properties in both locations.

NOTE: For Mapquest or similar, use Amsterdam, NY, 12010. For some GPS' try Fultonville, NY, 12072.

New Site = Aqueduct Picnic Area & Boat Launch Type In: Hartley Lane, Amsterdam, NY, 12010

If driving westbound on Rt. 5s from the Thruway or Rt 30: when you cross the maroon colored bridge, make your 1st right after approx. 200 yards onto Dufel Rd. / Hartley Lane. Stay Straight onto Hartley Lane to the end, you will see the area on the right. There is no street sign for Dufel Rd. or Hartley Lane out on Rt. 5s but, there is a small green pictorial sign indicating a boat launch just before the turn. Also, on the left side of 5s directly across from the turn is a large brown State Historical Site marker that says, "Aqueduct Picnic Area & Boat Launch".

You've gone too far, if you get to Karen's produce & Ice Cream on the left.

If driving eastbound on 5s from the Shrine: it will be the last left turn before the bridge, approx. 250yds. from Karen's Produce market, which is on the right. The green boat launch sign is not visible from this direction but, the large brown State Historical Site marker (on the right) is.

You've gone too far, if your crossing the bridge.





Parking: The Martyr's Shrine Bookstore Parking Lot will still be used on Saturday for all Pilgrim vehicles..

General Note: Shrine grounds are open to visit, but ONLY during daylight hours.

The Shrine Pavilion & attached field cannot be used this year. A new site for camping and Holy Masses has been secured. It is approx. 1.6 miles east on 5s from the base of 'Purgatory Hill' (Noeltner Rd.)

#### Overview

Arrow 1: New Site: There is a Boat Launch Site off of Rt. 5s on Hartley Lane that we have permission to use. This new site will host Friday, Saturday, and Sunday Holy Mass as well as camping. There is a small paved parking lot & some grassy area for tents and Camper trailers, etc.. on the right side of Hartley Lane only. Space is somewhat limited, parking & camp set up will be directed to gain efficient use of space. Access to the boat launch has to be unobstructed, as it will be in use by the general public. We will have portable facilities & water. NOTE: There is no municipal lighting. Bring light sources (flashlights, lanterns, torches etc).

#### Arrow 2: Saturday Parking

Saturday parking for vehicles is at the Shrine Bookstore Lot as usual & Pilgrims will be shuttled to the kick-off site from there only (This includes camping pilgrims). As a reminder, the Kick-off site is the old Lock 10 on the Erie Canal (off of Rt.5s). NOTE: Pilgrims who are not camping on-site should bring their Mass needs (i.e. Missals, Chapel Veils, etc.) with them to the Kick-off as there will not be a chance for you to get them before Mass is celebrated.
